



Getting started with your Veesus Point Clouds for Revit plug-in

This guide will help you get Veesus Point Clouds for Revit installed and running correctly. Please read through before you start, as depending on your setup you may need to do something slightly different in order to correctly install our software.

Please note that you must have an active Veesus subscription to use our software. If you haven't already subscribed to Veesus, [click here](#) to visit our website, scroll down to choose the tier you'd like to subscribe to, and follow the on-screen instructions.

Installation instructions for new users

1. Download Veesus Point Clouds for Revit [from our website](#). Note that the plug-in is currently only available for Revit 2022 and upwards. Ensure that Revit is closed **before** beginning installation
2. Once your software has downloaded, if installation does not start automatically click the '.exe' file and follow the on-screen prompts
3. Note that you **do not** need to check the "reset license" tickbox
4. If you have previously installed Veesus Point Clouds for Revit then you may get an error notification telling you that the .NET framework is already installed. Follow the prompts to continue the installation
5. Once the installation has completed, launch Revit. You should be automatically prompted to enter your Veesus subscription details
6. The plug-in is ready to use! You will need to use our free [VPC Creator](#) to work with your point clouds in Point Clouds for Revit; click the link above to download it

A note on VPC files

All Veesus software applications require point clouds to be converted into Veesus' proprietary VPC file format (.vpc) before they can be used by the software. Our VPC Creator is available to download for free from the Veesus website by clicking [here](#).
